# Canadian Army Western Command fonds. – 60 cm of textual records (3 boxes). – 1949-1969.

#### **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of files regarding the administration of the Canadian Army's Western Command during the 1950s and 1960s. Includes files on the Joint Services, the Joint Planning Committee, administration, conferences and meetings, the defence of ports, defences in general, military aid to civil power, collaboration with the United States, mobilization planning, emergency defence plans and military intelligence. Arranged in numerical order by the Central Registry file number.

#### **Administrative History**

Commands were introduced on January 23, 1946 replacing the existing system of military districts. Western Command, in British Columbia, Alberta, the Northwest Territories and the Yukon, included Military Districts 11 and 13. On January 1, 1947 MD11 became the British Columbia Area, part of Western Command and when MD13 ceased to exist, it was absorbed by Western Command.

Confidential and Secret files are dtored in Box 4.

#### **Associated Records**
