# 90 Canadian Headquarters and Signals Squadron fonds. – 5 m of textual records (25 boxes). – 1989-1991.

#### **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of files concerning Canada's participation in the Persian Gulf War of 1990-1991. Includes a wide variety of communication signals and messages that were transmitted and received from late January to March 1991. Also includes Central Registry files covering a wide variety of military subjects, including air tasking orders, military intelligence and Operation Desert Shield. There are also some miscellaneous files, including incoming and outgoing messages from the Canadian Liaison Officer, U.S. Central Command. There are three series:

- I. Communications Signals and Messages
- II. Central Registry Files
- III. General Files

#### **Administrative History**

In accordance with the Ministerial Organization Order 139/90 dated 17 December 1990, 90 Canadian Headquarters and Signals Squadron (CHSS) was organized as a unit of the Regular Forces. A Canadian joint air and naval headquarters under the command of Commodore Summers, was organized in October, 1990 to command Canadian Forces units in-theatre and to coordinate all the varied support activities involved in the effort. Canadian Forces Middle East (CANFORME) Headquarters was established at Manama City in Bahrain. A signals unit, 90 CHSS, was established to provide communication within the operational theatre and with Canada. The unit formed the core of the Headquarters with staff coming from Maritime and Air Commands and National Defence Headquarters (NDHQ). It was formed with an establishment of 160. The role of the unit was to provide staff, communications and first line administrative and logistics support necessary for the Commander of CANFORCOMME to exercise operational command of assigned forces. The unit was disbanded 3 June 1992.

# **Immediate Source of Acquisition**

The immediate source of acquisition is unknown.

#### Classification

Nearly all the files are classified.

#### Other Notes

There are Annual Historical Reports (AHRs) for the unit. The UIC number is 4777.

Series consists entirely of a wide variety of communication signals and messages that were transmitted and received from late January to March 1991 during the Persian Gulf War. They are divided into the 5 following subseries and are arranged in chronological order:

#### 1. RX Files (9-28 Feb 1991)

Includes messages from a variety of sources including Canadian Forces Communication Command (CFCC) Ottawa, U.S. Central Command Air Forces Intelligence, Defence Intelligence Agency Washington, Air Command Winnipeg and Canadian Air Task Group Middle East [CATGME]. The messages, in turn, were received at a variety of destinations, including 90 Canadian Signals Middle East, Canadian Forces Middle East and U.S. Central Command. There were a variety of documents included in the messages, including: Central Air Force air combat assessments, threat assessments, CATGME situation reports, CENTAF [U.S. Central Command Air Forces] Desert Storm intelligence summaries; military situation summaries; Operation Friction attached posting instructions; and airlift testing amendments.

## **Series 2: Central Registry Files**

#### **Series Description**

Series consists of files arranged in numerical order according to the file numbers created by the Central Registry system. The files cover a wide range of military subjects concerning the Persian Gulf War and Iraq-Kuwait crisis during 1990-1991. Some of the subjects include air tasking orders, military intelligence, Operation Desert Shield, Operation Unsheathed Sword, Operation Scapel and air operations. Includes intelligence summaries, situation reports, air tasking orders, communication messages and various other documents.

#### **Administrative History**

In 1950 National Defence Headquarters physically consolidated all the records operations under one organization, the Directorate of Central Registries. The three armed services and the Defence Research Board, maintained their own central registries within this structure, but a new registry was added to cover the administrative and operational activities that concerned all of the department. In effect, the Administration Central Registry were the records of Deputy Minister of National Defence, who was responsible for overall departmental administration, which included the continuing review of, and control over, the financial aspects of operations, logistics, personnel and administration.
