# Finding Aid to the Operation Friction collection (91/476)

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#### Operation Friction collection. – 1986-2000; dates predominant 1990-1992. – 93 cm of textual records

#### **Administrative History**

Operation Friction was the name attached to Canada's military commitment to the Persian Gulf crisis sparked by the Iraqui invasion of Kuwait in 1990. On 2 August 1990 the United Nations Security Council (UNCS) unanimously approved Resolution 661 imposing economic sanctions on Iraq. Many nations offered military forces to assist this effort. On 10 August the Prime Minister announced that Canada would contribute two destroyers and a supply ship to aid the multinational military effort in the Persian Gulf.

#### **Scope and Content**

Collection consists of material documenting OPERATION FRICTION, Canada's military commitment to the Persian Gulf War of 1990-1991. Includes administrative orders, signals and messages, and general reference documents, as well as draft chapters of the published work by Jean H. Morin and Richard H. Gimblett, "Operation Friction, 1990-1991: The Canadian Forces in the Persian Gulf". There are three series:

- I. Reference Files (1990-1992)
- II. "Operation Friction, 1990-1991: The Canadian Forces Operations in the Persian Gulf" material (1990-2000)
- III. Central Registry Files (1986-1991)

# Series 2: "Operation Friction, 1990-1991: The Canadian Forces Operations in the Persian Gulf" material

#### **Series Description**

Series consists of draft chapters of the published work by Jean H. Morin and Richard H. Gimblett entitled "Operation Friction, 1990-1991: The Canadian Forces Operations in the Persian Gulf". Includes some draft with comments and reviews, calendars of events and a synopsis covering the first 11 weeks of the operation. Also includes a contingency plan for Operation Broadsword that was prepared by Mobile Command Headquarters, St-Hubert, QC.

#### **Administrative History**

On 29 November, the Security Council passed a resolution authorizing "all necessary means" to evict Iraq from Kuwait by 15 January 1991. But a staff check, dubbed Operation BROADSWORD, had earlier determined that the despatch of an army brigade-group to the Gulf would take some six months to effect and would be too costly in terms of lives and material to warrant serious consideration.

### **Series 3: Central Registry Files series**

#### **Series Description**

Series consists of files arranged in numerical order according to the file numbers created by the Central Registry system. The files cover a wide range of military subjects concerning Operation Friction the Persian Gulf War of 1990-1991. Some of the subjects covered include: equipment and supplies, conferences and meetings, security, military intelligence, military transportation, military communications and military medicine.

Those files with no central registry number assigned to it are filed at the end of the series in alphabetical order by file title.

#### **Administrative History**

In 1950 National Defence Headquarters physically consolidated all the records operations under one organization, the Directorate of Central Registries. The three armed services and the Defence Research Board, maintained their own central registries within this structure, but a new registry was added to cover the administrative and operational activities that concerned all of the department. In effect, the Administration Central Registry were the records of Deputy Minister of National Defence, who was responsible for overall departmental administration, which included the continuing review of, and control over, the financial aspects of operations, logistics, personnel and administration.

#### Classification

One file is Unclassified (Box 3 File 7). The remaining files in Boxes 3-4 are Classified.
